

Asbestos & Lead Awareness **Training**

Job site safety is not only important, it's required and builders, remodelers and all trades people have an opportunity to make safety a priority. The Michigan Occupational Safety and Health Administration (MIOSHA) informed all Construction companies that they are **required by law** to provide asbestos awareness training for their employees who may contact, but do not disturb, asbestos-containing materials. Any home pre-1978 most likely has asbestos in it.



According to MIOSHA's Construction Safety Standards section R603: (iv) The employer shall also provide the training program at least annually for each employee who is subject to asbestos and lead exposure at or above the action level on any day.

This course has been approved for both residential builders pre-licensure and continuing safety training requirements and a certificate of attendance will be provided at the end of class.
